

Becoming a Member

There are two ways in which prospective Members can apply for Membership of The Clifton Club. The traditional route is through recommendation by two individuals who have been Members of the Club for three years or more. In this case, one Member must act as the proposer and another as a seconder. Alternatively, it is possible to take up probationary Membership which involves an initial trial period of four months, after which the application will be reviewed and the Member can be fully elected.

Incentives

If a new Member is introduced to the Club by an existing Member, as a thank you, the Club will reward the Member responsible for the introduction with credit on their account. Terms and conditions apply.
